- The Military Affairs Committee met with County Attorney Benjamin to finalize the settlement of the Military Pension Credit Grievance. Legislation to implement the settlement is scheduled to go to the County Council on November 4th.

Healthcare Review Committee - Mike DiCara

- Open enrollment for 2025 will take place from 11/1/24 to 11/30/24.
- The 2025 benefits guides and rate sheets for both active and retired members are now posted to the County's website.
- Baltimore County has opened a medical clinic for County Employees.

It is located at 305 Washington Avenue in the County's new office building. It is a small facility on the model of an "urgent care" with two exam rooms and an on-site lab. This facility is for County employees only and does not include dependents or retirees. It is run by "Evernorth", a subsidiary of Cigna and is totally free for County employees. There are no copays and your insurance isn't billed, which allows all County employees to use it, even those who don't have County insurance.

• This clinic will treat illnesses and minor injuries that do not require stitches or x-rays.

It will not be used for things like random drug testing or duty status examinations.
